that could sometimes be interpreted either as asexual or sexual the nature of this friendship is treated as ideal love as in the patriarchal convention sonnets 127 152 focus on the speaker s relationship with a woman the so called dark lady who is the counterpart of the innocent beautiful maid in patriarchal sonnets the lyrical i has an obsessive 1 sexual love affair with her i compare sonnets numbered 60 and 144 because the first one deals with the universal concerns of time and its passing and the second took note of the speaker s separation of physical love and more down to earth sensations connected with it moreover it is the only sonnet that explicitly refers to both the dark lady and the young man this sonnets are neatly organized following the structure of the shakespearean sonnet and its common rhyme scheme abab cdcd efef gg with a iambic pentameter bibliographie hahn peter 1995 geschichte der englischen lyrik 1 francke tbingen kerrigan j 1986 introduction in william shakespeare the sonnets and a lovers s complaint penguin classics harmondsworth senna c 2000 shakespeare s sonnets hungry minds inc new york
